

HIGHLIGHTS OF SEVERAL CRUCIAL DATE ON TRANSITION



- The transition period:
 - 30 Aug 2018 30 Aug 2021 (3 years)
- The expiry date of ISO 50001:2011 Certificates: 31 Aug 2021
- ACI deadline for accepting ISO 50001:2011 Certification application: 30 Aug 2020

When is the ISO 50001:2018 issued?

ISO 50001:2018 was issued in 30 August 2018



What are the major differences between ISO 50001:2011 and ISO 50001:2018?

- ISO 50001:2018 follows the high-level structure approach that is being applied to other ISO management system standards, such as ISO 9001:2015 (quality), ISO 14001:2015 (environment) and ISO 45001 (Occupational Health & Safety)
- ISO 50001:2018 requires more leadership and commitment of the top management.
- New requirements such context of the organization, needs and requirements of workers and other interested parties.
- ISO 50001:2018 Improved sections on data collection and normalization



We are going to implement an Energy management system (ISO 50001) for certification. What should we do?

There are two options

- i. You can directly implement the system in according with ISO 50001:2018 and apply for the certification of ISO 50001:2018;
- ii. Alternatively, if you have already begun to set up the system based on ISO 50001:2011, you can go ahead to obtain the ISO 50001:2011 certificate first and later do the transition to ISO 50001:2018 on or before the deadline specified by ACI.



What are the core concepts of ISO 50001:2018?

- Energy Performance indicators (EnPls)
- Risk-based thinking



We have got ISO 50001:2011 Certificate already. What is the impact of the new standard on us?

According to the resolution of International Accreditation Forum (IAF), there is a 3 years transition period from the issue date of ISO 50001:2018 for all existing ISO 50001:2011 Certificates to transit to ISO 50001:2018 Certificate.

Therefore, all ISO 50001:2011 Certificates will be expired on 31 Aug 2021 (i.e. the ISO 50001:2011 Certificates will have lost validity since 31 Aug 2021).



Is there any deadline for application for ISO 50001:2011 Certification?

ACI welcomes ISO 50001:2011 Certification application made during the Transition Period provided that such application should not be made after 22 Aug 2020, i.e. after the first two year of the 3-year Transition Period.

The reason for setting this deadline is to ensure sufficient time for the certified clients to prepare the transition after being certified for ISO 50001:2011.







When should we do the transition?

During the Transition Period, the ISO 50001:2011 certified clients can choose to transit at any time provided that the deadline of successful transition is 22 Aug 2021. The clients can decide their schedule for transition.

However, it is highly recommended for the clients to complete the transition as early as possible

- i. to avoid the transition peak;
- ii. to leave enough time for the submission of plans of correction and corrective actions and the arrangement of any follow up visits if there were non-conformities (NCs) raised in the transition audit(s).

(* Remark : ACI' s deadline for Audit(s) of Transition is **30 June 2021**.)



How should we start for the transition?

- i) Review ISO 50001:2018;
- ii) Implement the system in accordance with the ISO 50001:2018;
- iii) Plan the transition;
- iv) Discuss with ACI the plan and reserve the date(s) for Transition Audit(s).



What is the transition process?

For ACI, all ISO 50001:2011 certified clients seeking ISO 50001:2018 transition shall undergo a Transition Audit(s). Normally, there are two types of Transition Audit: one-off audit or staged audit.

- i) For One-Off Transition Audit, the audit will be a one-time audit in which the fulfillment of the clients' ISO 50001:2011 against all the ISO 50001:2018 requirements will be evaluated within the same audit. It can be carried out together with the normal scheduled audits such as Surveillance Visit (SV) or Renewal Audit or in a single independent audit.
- ii) For staged type, the evaluation of the fulfillment of the clients' ISO 50001:2011 against the ISO 50001:2018 requirements will be conducted in several planned audits provided that the accumulative results of these audits can prove the full fulfillment of the client's ISO 50001:2011 with ISO 50001:2018.

Each audit of Transition Audits in such case can be carried out together with the normal scheduled audits such as Surveillance Visit (SV) or Renewal Audit or a single independent audit.

Point to note:

For the staged type, during each audit of the Transition Audits, as the ISO 50001:2011 is not or has not been evaluated to be fully complied with ISO 50001:2018, the normal audit for ISO 50001:2011 will be still carried out. Please make sure to maintain effectively the ISO 50001:2011 before the completion and success of the transition.







How should we choose between one-off type and staged type Transition Audit(s)?

The choice for one-off type or staged type Transition Audit(s) may have impact in terms of clients' internal manpower arrangement or business plan. Clients are advised to have a comprehensive consideration before making decision and discuss with ACI if necessary.



How does ACI begin the transition for the clients?

ACI is well prepared for the transition for the clients. Our audit team will introduce the publication of ISO 50001:2018 and the transition issues to all the clients of ISO 50001:2011 during the normal visit. Clients are welcomed to discuss with the relevant issues with our audit team. Once the client confirmed the transition audit schedule, our audit team will conduct the transition for the client according to the agreed schedule.



What does ACI do to assist certified clients for the transition?

Besides, the above mentioned Preliminary Gap Analysis, in order to get our clients more familiar with the ISO 50001:2018 requirements and facilitate our clients' preparation for the transition, ACI with pleasure provides the following training and services:
